

## ACCESS STATEMENT

### **HORIZONS, 5 the Lookout, Packet Quays, High Street Falmouth TR11 2UE**

## INTRODUCTION

Horizons is a modern self-catering holiday apartment designed to cater for up to four guests. The property is situated at the top of Falmouth High Street, with access either from the High Street (secure locked access opposite the Star and Garter or through the private parking area) or from Harbour Terrace which runs along the top of the Lookout.

## ARRIVAL

### **Arrival in Falmouth:**

If you are arriving by air, you may fly into several different British airports; Newquay, <http://www.newquaycornwallairport.com/> Bristol <http://www.bristolairport.co.uk/> or one of the London airports. <http://www.londonnet.co.uk/ln/guide/resources/airports.html>

If you choose not to hire a car at the airport, the simplest way of reaching Falmouth is by train and excellent travel bargains can be obtained by booking in advance on <http://www.firstgreatwestern.co.uk/>

In the event of arrival by train in Falmouth (change at Truro) the quickest way of reaching Horizons is to leave the train at Falmouth Town, where a local shuttle service is available regularly during the day, the nearest stop to Horizons being Prince of Wales Pier. From there, walk up the High Street to the archway which stretches across the road. Alternatively, taxi services are available , for example:

The taxi ride to Harbour Terrace is under 1,5 miles and should take about 7 or 8 minutes.

Car hire is available in Falmouth if you wish to take up this option, or alternatively there are good bus routes to most nearby towns and popular destinations, see [http://www.firstgroup.com/ukbus/devon\\_cornwall/](http://www.firstgroup.com/ukbus/devon_cornwall/)

By car, follow the A39 from Truro into Falmouth

### **Arrival at Horizons:**

Access to the High Street entrance and the entrance to the car park (corner of Beacon Street and High Street) is only possible once you have entered 5 The Lookout from Harbour Terrace and collected the remote control for the car park entrance and the special key to the High Street door. If you arrive by car from Truro, follow Dracaena Avenue, then turn left into Berkeley Vale. Take a left-hand turning into Erisey Terrace, which in turn becomes Harbour Terrace. The entrance to The Lookout is through a small wrought-iron gate on the right-hand side of the road, just before the end of the Terrace and the Boathouse public house. By taxi, ask the driver to take you to Harbour Terrace via Trelawney Road. If you arrive on foot from Prince of Wales Pier, go to the top of the High Street, turn left into Beacon Street and then immediately twice left into Trevethan road and Harbour Terrace. From this end of Harbour Terrace, the gateway is about 20 yards along on the left.

When you enter the Lookout development, walk down 29 steps and you will find Horizons (no. 5) on your left.

The keys to the front door of Horizons are stored in a key safe at the entrance to the apartment (the code will be sent to you about three weeks before your arrival date). The larger key opens both the top and the bottom locks of the stable-type door, and the smaller one operates the Yale lock.

Inside the apartment you will find the remote control for access to the car park (space no 37 - enter the car park and go up two levels – the space is on the left) and the key which you will need to access and leave the development by the stairs through the car park leading to the High Street). Emergency numbers will be available in case of any difficulty encountered.

Please note that the car parking space can accommodate vehicles up to a maximum height of 77".

## **YOUR STAY IN HORIZONS**

Every effort has been made to provide all the necessary equipment to ensure a comfortable stay in Horizons: if however you consider that any indispensable article appears to be lacking, the owner would be grateful for your opinion. You will find a supply of products for everyday cleaning, as well as for the washing machine and the dishwasher.

Smoking is not permitted inside the apartment, and it is unfortunately not possible to accept pets.

As stated on our website, due to the access which is solely via stairs, the property is unfortunately not recommended for very young children or people with mobility difficulties.

During your stay, please take into account that there are neighbours and other holiday-makers very close by, and refrain from making undue noise or creating disturbances, in particular when coming in at night.

Dustbins are situated at the entrance to the car park, and if necessary, there is a household waste recycling centre in Longdowns.

On departure, it would be appreciated if you would strip the bed(s) and put all the laundry into the bath tub in order to facilitate the work of our housekeeper.

If you are leaving the property through the car park, please make sure that you replace the access key inside the apartment on departure.

## **LOCAL AMENITIES AND LEISURE ACTIVITIES**

Shopping: Tesco Metro, Londis and Marks and Spencer are all within easy walking distance of Horizons. There are branches of most major banks, a wide selection of art galleries, charity shops, pubs, cafés and restaurants as well as numerous clothing outlets and other well-known High Street stores. Pasties are available from several outlets, and certain pubs welcome patrons who bring in their own food.

Leisure facilities: The Carrick Leisure Services <http://www.carrickleisureservices.org.uk/> provide a wide range of facilities, and fishing trips are available from Prince of Wales Pier. Gyllingvase and Maenporth are renowned for their large sandy beaches, and the golf course in Swanpool is a short distance from the centre of Falmouth <http://www.falmouthgolfclub.com/>
